This action handbook provides climate science, stories of climate change, and tips on helping in the fight against climate change.

Klein, Naomi. *This Changes Everything: Capitalism vs the Climate*. New York: Simon & Schuster, 2014.

This book details the politics surrounding climate change and provides a new way of thinking about the climate crisis as a rallying call to transform our economic system and build a better world.

Kolbert, Elizabeth. *The Sixth Extinction: An Unnatural History*. Bloombury: London, 2014.

Kolbert investigates the mass extinction taking place now through the stories of various species and scientists.

McKibben, Bill. *Oil and Honey: The Education of an Unlikely Activist*. New York: Time Books, 2013.

Writer, activist and founder of 350.org, Bill McKibben shares his story revealing the challenges and issues surrounding climate change activism.

McMichael, Anthony. *Climate Change and the Health of Nations: Famines, Fevers, and the Fate of Populations*. New York: Oxford University Press, 2017.

This book looks at agricultural civilization's dependence on the environment and the necessity of stable climatic conditions.

Schumacher, EF. *Small Is Beautiful: Economics as if People Mattered*. New York: Harper Perennial, 2010 (reprint).

First published in 1970s, the ideas within are more relevant now than ever.

The authors provide a broad overlook at historic and current environmental issues and their champions.
